**Year #6**: 2009-2010 – Opening enrollment of 110 – closed with 120 – Annual K5 Graduation with 25 Graduates – Annual 3<sup>rd</sup> Grade Finale with 10 students And 2<sup>nd</sup> 3-Day "Senior Class" Trip to Washington, DC!

Year #7: 2010-2011 – Opening enrollment of 110 – closed with 118 – Annual K5 Graduation with 24 Graduates – Annual 3<sup>rd</sup> Grade Finale with 8 students And Finally a visit to the White House; During President Obama's 1<sup>st</sup> Term As President!

**Year #8**: 2011-2012 – Opening enrollment of 90 – closed with 106 – Annual K5 Graduation with 20 Graduates – Annual 3<sup>rd</sup> Grade Finale with 6 students and 1<sup>st</sup> Senior Trip to Williamsburg!

**Year #9**: 2012-2013 – Opening enrollment of 120! – closed with 134!! – Opened with an <u>Awesome New Playground!!</u> – Annual K5 Graduation with 26 Graduates – And <u>No</u> Ending Finale for Our 12 3<sup>rd</sup> Graders but an Upper Class Trip to Williamsburg!

Year #10: 2013-2014 – Opening enrollment of 127! – Closed with 138!! – Opened with A New 4th Grade Class of 12 students! – Annual K5 Graduation with 25 Graduates - A Year of 10th Anniversary Celebrations Including: A Homecoming & Grand Reunion Weekend – Scholarship Banquet – Volunteers & Donors Thank You Weekend – 1st Annual Grandparents Day - 5 Day Finale Trip to Orlando!

**Year #11**: 2014-2015 – Opened with 120 students – closed with 147!! - Opened with A New 5<sup>th</sup> Grade Class of 13 students! – Annual K5 Graduation with 29 Graduates – 1<sup>st</sup> 5<sup>th</sup>-Grade "Crossing Over" Ceremony with 13 Seniors and a Senior Trip to Richmond!

Year #12: 2015-2016 – Opened with 126 students – closed with 136!! – Went "Green" with emailed Teachers' Weekly and Director's Monthly Newsletters – Awarded a Grant for 30 Tablets – Awesome K5 Graduation (30 students) AND 5<sup>th</sup> Grade "Crossing Over" Ceremony (7 students) And 3 Day Finale Trip to the D.C. Area and White House During President Obama's 2<sup>nd</sup> Term!

Year #13: 2016-2017—Opened with 152 students-Our 1st Time Reaching/Exceeding Our Goal of 150 students!-Awesome K5 Graduation (29students); 5th Grade "Crossing Over" Ceremony (8 students) AND a 5 Day Finale' Trip to Atlanta! And to God Goes All the Glory!!

Year #14: 2017-2018 – Opened again with 152 students – Closed with 162! Celebrated READY's 1st K5 Grads of 2006 –Now High School Grads, 2018! –12 of the Original 14 marched with Our 30 K5 Grads! – They received \$8,500.00 in Scholarships! – 5th Grade "Crossing Over" Ceremony (10 Students) And 3 Day Finale' Trip to Williamsburg /Great Wolf Lodge!

Year #15: 2018-2019 – Opened with 159 students – closed with 164! – With A Match From An Angel Donor, Opened Our 1st Foundation Fund (in the Hampton Roads Foundation) with \$50,000 – Awesome K5 Graduation (36 Students) And 5th Grade Crossing Over (9 Students) AND A 5 Day Finale' Trip to New York! Celebrated 14 – 2nd Year K5 Grads Graduating High School with \$9,500 in Scholarships!

Year #16: 2019-2020 – Opened with 158 Students – Physically closed in March Due to OCVID19 – But blessed to Close Virtually with 141! Foundation Fund grew to \$75,000 – Awesome Virtual K5 Graduation (23 students) and 5<sup>th</sup> Grade Crossing Over (7 students). No Senior Trip But A "Grateful" End of the Year "Drive Thru" Celebration!

Year #17: Opened 100% Virtually with only 99 students—Teachers Trained Weekly in latest Technology—Creativity provided Our Special Programs Virtually. March 15, 2021 opened its Combined In-Person and Virtual School—enrollment of 105!—STEMA Fair Virtual and In-Person, with Special T-shirts from PSTA!—In-Person 5th Grade Crossing Over (9 students) and K5 Graduation (12 students), also Live Streamed! Another End-of-the-Year "Drive-Thru" Celebration.—Grateful to God to Survive and Thrive!

Year #18: Opened in Person- with 115 Students- Although we stayed masked-up, our students were able to thrive academically while bridging the educational gap caused by COVID 19. End of the Year Hybrid 5<sup>th</sup> Grade "Crossing Over Ceremony", with 9 Graduates and Hybrid Kindergarten Graduation with 22 Graduates. This was the 2nd High School and College Alumni Graduate Recognition and Scholarship Awards given.

**Year #19:** Opened in Person with 134 Students. Kindergarten Graduation consisted of 20 Graduates. This was our 3<sup>rd</sup> Alumni Graduate Recognition with 17 High School Graduates and 6 College Graduates receiving Named Scholarship Awards. Fund Raisers were a Tremendous Success. We started our 1<sup>st</sup> STEMA Fair, bringing PK3-K5 together and 1<sup>st</sup>-5<sup>th</sup> together in Taste N See Auditorium with Student Projects being Judged Nightly. Each Grade Level received 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, or 3<sup>rd</sup> place Awards.

I pray that God the Father, Son and Holy Spirit, will be our TEAM Leader and continue to grant "Favor" to <u>HIS</u> READY Academy Christian School. "THANK YOU! THANK YOU!! THANK YOU!!!"

- 3. I understand that the tuition is divided into 10 equal monthly payments, beginning August thru May OR Other Payment Options of Yearly or Bi-Yearly Tuition Payments are available.
- 4. I agree to pay the Tuition Fee on the 1st of each month and according to the terms of my financial agreement. If the 1st is on the weekend, I agree to pay tuition on the following Monday. Late fees will be applied on the sixth day of each month.
- 5. No student will be permitted to attend school if the tuition is more than 30 days past due. Report cards and other records will be held until the tuition balance is zero. Non-Essential School Trips and/or graduation participation can be withheld until all financial obligations are met.
- 6. The tuition fee will be paid via Procare in the form of credit/debit card, electronic check, money order or cashier's check. Cash is not accepted for tuition payments.
- 7. If tuition is not paid prior to the close of business on the fifth day of the month, a Late Payment Fee of \$25.00 will be automatically posted to the student's account.
- 8. A \$25.00 Stop Payment Fee will be assessed for any stopped automatic tuition payment or stopped payments on personal/business checks.
- 9. I agree to pay the full monthly tuition fee even if my child is absent for one or more days during that month.
- 10. I agree to pay a Late Pickup Fee per child for each minute my child is not picked up from School past the designated pick-up time. A late pick-up fee will be charged for each minute after the closing time of 6:00 p.m. for Extended Day Students and each minute after 3:35PM for Academic Day Students.
- 11. I agree to complete an official form to change the "Tuition Rate and Term of Day, in accordance with my tuition contract. I also agree to submit the above referenced form no later than the 15th of the month, prior to the change being in effect.
- 12. I agree and understand that if my child has a pattern of staying beyond the "Term-of-Day" that I selected, I will be assessed the entire tuition rate that coincides with the extended time they were present at READY Academy.
- 13. Any parent receiving funding from external providers, such as an EMPLOYER RELATED TUITION REIMBURSEMENT PROGRAMS, WORKFORCE CHILDCARE REIMBURSEMENT PROGRAM, etc.), must inform a finance administrator of his/her intent to use this funding to subsidize tuition. Parents receiving this funding must also attend a financial assistance meeting with a finance administrator to ensure that the parent understands his/her financial commitment beyond the external funding; and to ensure that all necessary paperwork is completed.
- 14. Multiple Siblings Discount Rule: A 10% Discount will be applied to each additional sibling after the 1st enrolled student. The discount will be applied to the sibling(s) with the higher tuition rate. (NOT TO BE COMBINED w/OTHER DISCOUNTS).
- 15. All Accounts Must Receive Clearance before a child's name can be placed on the travel roster for the Upper Class & Senior Trip. Accounts must also be Granted Clearance (3) "Business Days" Prior to the date of travel.
- 16. IN ORDER TO ACQUIRE APPROVAL FOR ANY SPECIALIZED PAYMENT ARRANGEMENT, A FORMAL REQUEST NEEDS TO BE SUBMITTED DIRECTLY TO A FINANCE ADMINISTRATOR. ALL ADDENDUM FORMS/STIPULATIONS MUST BE FULLY ADHERED TO AND DOCUMENTED/SIGNED BY THE FINANCE ADMINISTRATOR IN ORDER TO MAINTAIN ENROLLMENT.
- 17. Withdrawal Procedure & Policy: Any student withdrawing during the school year for medical reasons or for military relocation must submit official documentation 30 days prior to the date of the official withdrawal. All Official Withdrawal Forms must be completed by both a Parent/Guardian and a READY Academy Student Account Representative before a withdrawal is considered official. There must also be a zero balance on the student account before a withdrawal is considered official. All student records will be held until there is a zero balance on the account. All other withdrawals will be assessed 30% of the remaining contract.
- 18. Parent Volunteer Hour Addendum: In an attempt to maintain low and competitive tuition rates, READY Academy requires that all READY families complete a total of 4 volunteer hours. (**REFER TO VOLUNTEER GUIDELINES**)

#### TEMPORARY HOLD GUIDELINES FOR DELINQUENT ACCOUNT POLICY

A suspension of a student's account is a rare occurrence. But when it occurs, it can be inconvenient for both the parent and the student. READY Academy makes every attempt to avoid these circumstances; however, they do sometimes occur. Listed below are reasons why a student account will be suspended and the procedure that must be followed in order to re-instate the student account:

- 1. A temporary hold of all academic and/or extended-care services will be executed due to failure to submit all requested/required documentation.

- ➤ The Student account will no longer be eligible for any payment plan or financial assistance for the next 10 month academic year.
- ➤ An Appointment for reinstatement must be requested in writing and submitted to a finance administrator. (Yellow Appointment Slips are located at the Payment Station)

#### **General School Rules**

- 1. Students are expected to walk in the hallways. Horseplay will not be tolerated at any time in the school or outside on the playground.
- 2. No toys or non-school items are allowed on school property, unless pre-approved and announced by the Director.

### A daily check of book bags is advised to see what your child is taking or bringing to school.

- 3. Students are expected to wear required regulation school uniforms daily unless change is pre-approved by the Director,
  Black Tennis shoes or black rubber sole closed toe and heel shoes are needed for school and physical education. Flip-flops are not permitted.
  - Apparel, which advertises, glorifies, or symbolizes any illegal substance or substances illegal for the use of minors may not be worn. No clothing with objectionable printed slogans or pictures may be worn.
  - No bare midriff or revealing tank tops may be worn.
  - Short skirts or extremely short shorts may not be worn.
  - Hats are not to be worn in the building.
- **4.** Students are expected to have supplies at school at all times.

#### **COMMUNICATION**

Effective education of children requires cooperation between home and school. Parents are informed of their child's progress in school through interim progress reports and formal report cards which are sent home at the end of each nine-week period.

#### **Home Work Folder**

The homework folder will be sent home nightly. We ask that you check it each night to see what your child needs to do for homework and for communication from school. **Parents must sign completed homework nightly.** 

#### **Conferences**

Conferences are arranged for all parents at the end of the first nine-week period and whenever requested by the teacher and/or parent during the school year. In January, we hold a second conference. Both conferences include evening hours for our parents who work during the day. Parent-Teachers Conferences are invaluable for both parents and the teachers. Parents can see a showcase of their child's work that progress reports will never reveal. Teachers can explain the child's strengths and weaknesses that a narrative summary may not be able to describe. More importantly, the child sees their parents and teachers meeting together to support his/her educational program.

#### **Phone Conferences**

The staff at READY Academy does not adhere to the expression that "no news is good news". We strongly believe that parents appreciate a positive phone call from school that reports our children's success. We also appreciate your feedback from home, even when you are satisfied with your child's instruction.

#### **Weekly Parent Bulletin**

A newsletter is sent home at least once a month. The newsletter is the Director's way of keeping you informed about our school and about important dates to remember. It is very IMPORTANT to read ALL newsletters, whether online or in hard copy. Teachers send weekly newsletters to keep parents informed about the educational "excitement" in the classroom.

#### **PSTA Plans an Exciting Year!**

Thanks to all of you for your wonderful support of the READY Academy Parent Student Teachers Association (PSTA). We are planning exciting activities for the coming school year. We encourage you to join the PSTA immediately and invest \$5.00 in your child's future. We need your support. Studies have shown that the more active parents are in their child's school, the better the child performs. We believe we provide opportunities for fun and education in which your family will want to participate.

Included is a calendar of PSTA meetings and events for the year. Your attendance at these events is important and your child will benefit from your presence at school. Please Mark these dates down! PSTA Board will meet monthly as indicated in their calendar.

#### **ATTENDANCE**

Children need to understand the importance of and develop an appreciation for school during their elementary years. We will be unable to promote the importance of school if children do not attend on a regular basis.

A record is kept of students' absences and tardiness. Parents of those children who are absent/or consistently late more than 15 days will receive a letter informing them of this attendance concern. Excessive absences can and may affect students' passage to the next grade.

Tardiness is very disruptive to the instructional process. Most children also benefit from having a few moments of organizational time in the morning.

#### **ARRIVAL/DISMISSAL PROCEDURES**

Students are not allowed to leave the school building and the grounds with anyone other than their parent/quardian and persons listed on Authorization for Pick Up form unless the parent or guardian makes a written and dated request. A picture I.D is required the first time each different authorized adult (18 and older) comes in for pick-up. Students must be signed out in the office by the parent/designee prior to leaving the school grounds. Unfamiliar individuals will be required to show picture identification to office personnel before the child can be released. All adults signing a child out from school are required to sign our log. For your child's safety, we will only accept from the parent or legal guardian any change of dismissal over the phone. It is preferred that parents/quardians send a note to school in the morning if you plan to change the dismissal plan for that day.

#### School Closing or Delayed Openings:

On occasion, school will be closed or will have a delay in its opening due to inclement weather. When such conditions exist, you are encouraged to watch all of the local Television Stations for complete information on school openings and closings. The READY Academy will follow the Norfolk Public Schools' inclement weather opening and closing procedures.

#### **EMERGENCY SCHOOL CLOSING**

Parents will be asked to complete and return to school the Emergency Contact Information Form.

#### **HEALTH AND SAFETY**

#### **Accident/Dental Insurance**

The READY Academy School Board endorses an insurance policy, which covers accidents from the time the student leaves for school until he/she returns home. The cost of this policy is included in the student's resource fee.

#### **Change of Address and Telephone Numbers**

For the safety and welfare of the children, it is imperative for the school to have the child's current address and telephone number(s). Parents are required to inform the school of any address, home or work telephone number changes during the school year. Parents must designate additional emergency contact person(s).

#### **EVACUATION DRILLS**

Fire, lockdown, active shooter and tornado evacuation drills will be conducted during the school year. Fire drills are conducted monthly during the school year. Lockdown drills are held each semester. Tornado drills are held on the state of Virginia's tornado drill day.

#### **Health Care**

Parents are called if their child has a fever or appears to be suffering from an illness or injury. Children with a fever should be fever-free for 24 hours before returning to school. Parents are contacted immediately if their child is suspected of having a contagious disease. Once a contagious disease is diagnosed, the child must remain at home until the symptoms have disappeared.

Occasionally ringworm is a problem in schools. If a child is sent home to treat this situation, he/she may not return until a doctor has determined that the child may return to school. A doctor's written slip is required.

#### Medication

The school staff may administer no external or internal medication, including aspirin, without the proper documentation from a physician. If a child needs regular medicine, the parent must contact the Principal so the appropriate arrangements can be made. A note from the doctor stating the dosage and duration of medication is required. Medication must be in a prescription bottle labeled with the child's name. Medication must be taken to the office by the parent and cannot be brought by the child.

#### **Visitors**

Visitors and parents are welcomed to visit our school. All persons are required to report to the office upon entering the building to pick up a visitor's badge and to sign-in and sign-out. All visitors are required to wear a visitor's badge while they remain in the building and on school grounds. Visitors are required to sign-out when they leave and turn in their visitor's badge.

Parent volunteers are also required to report to the office to pick up a <u>volunteer's badge</u> and to sign the <u>volunteer book as well</u>.

#### **STUDENT CONDUCT**

Our Director and School Board work hard to ensure that our students are educated in a safe school environment. Student conduct plays an important part in ensuring safety and in creating an atmosphere that is conducive for proper learning. READY Academy Christian School is very proud of the positive environment it has established for its children, parents, staff, and visitors. Based on the school's Code of Student Conduct, guidelines have been established by the classroom teachers and the school in order to

maintain this environment. School regulations apply in the school building, on the school grounds, and at any event where the school is represented.

As school is the first institution outside of the home where students learn, we stress the importance of respecting the rights and property of others, being helpful to other students and to adults, resolving disagreements in appropriate ways, and just learning how to be good citizens.

#### The Golden Rules of the READY Academy;

- All students must, at all times, show respect for God, teacher, other adults, other students and themselves.
- 2. All students must follow directions the first time.
- 3. All students must learn to the best of their ability.

Unfortunately, there are times when a child might forget how to be a good citizen or disregard the practices of proper conduct. Whenever this occurs, the teacher or the school administrator may have to intervene with some form of discipline such as the taking away of privileges, placing a child on a behavioral contract, holding conferences with the child's parent(s), or removing the child from the classroom or school for a specific period of time. However, in order for the child to learn the importance of proper conduct, it is imperative that the parent be supportive of the action(s) taken to help correct the problem. All of our children benefit from seeing the home and school working together on one accord.

### STUDENT RECOGNITIONS Students of the Week

Students of the Week are recognized each week with a certificate and a special treat. Please look for names on our designated bulletin board.

(Please notify your child's teacher if you would like to bring in special treats to celebrate your child's birthday.)

#### **Display of Student Work**

Children get a real sense of pride when their work is displayed for everyone to see. Look for your child's work displayed in our classrooms and hallways.

#### **Perfect Attendance**

Student achievement is directly tied to attendance. In order for students to take advantage of all that our school has to offer, they need to attend regularly. We recognize perfect attendance in extra special ways. Perfect Attendance is defined as a student who attends 75% or more of each school day; for the school year.

#### **ACADEMIC FOCUS**

Parents and students are reminded that a child's only job is to come to school each day prepared to learn as much as he/she possibly can. Our students will focus on the Bible, the Major Academic Courses including Phonics, Reading, Arithmetic, Handwriting, Science, Social Studies; and Special Focus on Science, Technology, Engineering, the Arts and Mathematics (STEAM). It is our obligation to prepare students as much as possible for the 21st century and beyond. This is a school where "failure is not an option, mediocrity is unacceptable and excellence is our standard."

#### **Documentation Requests**

It may be purchased at Office Max, Office Depot, Wal-Mart, or the Dollar Store. (Other choices are available as well. These are suggestions.)

- All students and parents are <u>required</u> to participate. Please make this a family project. #### READY's 20 Daily Rules for Polishing Our Students for a Successful Life

- Rule # 1 When responding to any adult, you must answer by saying "Yes ma'am or No sir". Just nodding your head or saying any other form of yes or no is not acceptable.
- Rule # 2 Make eye contact. When someone is speaking, keep your eyes on him or her at all times. If someone makes a comment, turn and face that person.
- Rule #3 Always say "Thank You" when someone gives you something. If you do not say it within three seconds after receiving the item, it will be taken back. There is no excuse for not showing appreciation.
- Rule # 4 Answer questions with a complete sentence. Also, in conversation with others, it is important to use complete sentences out of respect for the person's question. For example, if a person asks, "How are you?" instead of just responding by saying, "Fine," you should say, "I am doing fine, thank you. "How about yourself?"
- Rule # 5 Homework will be turned in each day, (Tuesday Friday and usually for each subject) by every student with no exceptions.
- Rule # 6 When we are in transition from one subject to the other, the change will be swift, quiet, and orderly. We should consistently be able to turn from one book to another, complete with all homework and necessary materials, as quickly as possible.
- Rule # 7 We will follow certain classroom protocols. We will be organized, efficient, and on task. In order to do so, we will follow these rules:
  - A. Do not get out of your seat without permission. Exception: If you are sick, raise your hand and leave immediately.
  - B. Do not speak unless:
    - 1. You raise your hand, and the teacher calls on you.
    - 2. Teacher asks you a question and you are responding
    - 3. It is recess or lunch
    - 4. Teacher instructs you otherwise
- Rule #8 Flush the toilet and wash your hands after using the rest room. When you are in a public rest room, get a paper towel before washing your hands, use the paper towel to turn off the faucets and press the dispenser to get another paper towel to dry your hands. (Or use the towel to press the button to start the dryer.) The last thing you want to do is touch areas with clean hands that others have touched with dirty hands.
- Rule #9 We will often have visitors to our school. If someone is coming to visit your class, the teacher may send two students to the front door of the building. If so, student(s) will welcome the person to our school. Then take the person to the front office and introduce them to whoever is in the front office. Afterwards give them a brief tour of the building as you bring him or her to the classroom. —For PK3 thru K5, a teacher will assist the 2 selected students.
- Rule # 10 The ABC's Etiquette manners when dealing with food:
  - A. When you first sit down for a meal, immediately place your napkin in your lap. If your silverware is wrapped in a napkin, unwrap it as soon as you sit down and place the napkin in your lap.
  - B. When you finish eating, place your napkin beside your plate. Don't crumble it because you don't want to seem untidy.
  - C. Never place your elbows on the table.

- Rule # 11 After we eat we will clean up after ourselves. This includes cleaning off the tables and making sure we have not left any trash on the floor or around the eating area. It is important to be responsible for your trash no matter where you are and be sure not to litter.
- Rule # 12 When we ride on a bus or van, we will always sit facing forward. We will never turn around to talk to other students or get up out of our seats. When we exit the bus or van, we will always thank the driver and tell him or her to have a good day.
- Rule # 13 When we are on a field trip, there will be no talking as we enter the building.
- Rule # 14 During chapel or any program do not speak and do not look around and try and get the attention of your friends in your or other classes.
- Rule # 15 When in line, walk single file, two or three feet behind the person in front of you with your arms by your side, (or your teacher may require "Bubbles and Hands in the back). Always respect other's personal space. Absolutely no talking in line.
- Rule # 16 Never cut line. If someone cuts in front of you, do not say or do anything about it. Let it happen, but let the teacher know about it quietly after we return to our classroom. The teacher will handle the situation. If you fuss with someone who has cut line, then the both of you will be in trouble with the teacher. Handle all other disputes the same way. Come to the teacher quietly about any problem. Your teacher will handle it. "Tatter Tails" are unacceptable in our classroom.
- Rule # 17 If any child in this school is bothering you, let your teacher know. Your teacher is here to protect you. Bullying at this school is unacceptable and will not be tolerated.
- Rule # 18 No matter what the circumstances, ALWAYS be HONEST. Even if you have done something wrong, it is best to admit it to your teacher, because your teacher will respect that, and oftentimes he/she may forget any disciplinary measures because of your honesty. Always strive to be the best you can be.
- Rule # 19

  If you are asked a question in conversation, you should ask a question in return. If someone asks, "Did you have a nice weekend?" you should answer the question and then ask a question in return. For example: "Did you have a nice weekend?" Answer "Yes, I had a great time. My family and I went shopping. What about you? Did you have a nice weekend? Did you have a nice weekend?"
- Rule # 20 You will make every effort to be as organized as possible.
