Book Review Format for 1st Grade

Create a Glossary and Word Search! Each student creates a glossary of fifteen (15) or more words that are specific to the book's tone, setting, or characters. The student defines each word and writes a sentence from the book that includes that word. Then the *student* creates a word search puzzle that includes the glossary words. Students can exchange their glossaries and word searches with others in class on Presentation Day.
