Required Reading

Each student must read and submit a report using the defined format:

<u>Freckle Juice</u> By Judy Blume or <u>God's Dream</u> By Archbishop Desmond Tutu & Douglas Carlton Abrams

Book Review Format for 3rd Grade

The student will write a letter to a friend, summarizing their book. The letter should include: Date, Greeting, Body (3) paragraphs and a closing. First paragraph must be what the student thought the book was about. Second paragraph must be what the author actually wrote (the author's point of view). The third paragraph must be student's overall enjoyment of the book. (i.e. I really enjoyed this book because...). The report must be in a cover; with a cover sheet including the name and address of their friend centered in the middle of the paper; with student's name and address in the top left hand corner, neatly written in cursive or typed. Extra points will be given for a typed paper.
